AKC NEWS

At the AKC delegates meeting March 2012, the proposal to change the rules and expand the current seven variety groups to eleven groups, did not get the required two-thirds vote. If this had been approved, the Hound group would have been split into 2 groups: sighthounds and scenthounds. Since this is the second time, the "realignment" effort, has failed, it is not expected to be tried again in the foreseeable future.

The AKC Board approved the following groups of states, for conformation points, effective May 2012: The Board also changed the formula, so that points will be calculated from only 1 past year's entries, rather than 3 past year's entries. These changes have resulted in less borzoi needed for a 3 point major in most states.

The Board VOTED to grant the Peruvian Inca Orchid eligibility to compete in AKC Lure Coursing events, effective September 1, 2012.

The Board VOTED to change the Agility, Obedience, Rally and Tracking Regulations, to allow clubs at their discretion the right to offer a lower entry fee for dogs entered in these events that are handled by a Junior Handler. This is effective for events applied for after January 1, 2013.

The Board has approved the following policy concerning grooming space at AKC Conformation Events: All clubs are required to set aside an area that is reserved for grooming that is reasonable in size for the entry of the show. At least 50% of this space must be available for exhibitors including "Day-of-event" exhibitors and be designated as unpaid grooming space. This space must be in a reasonable/convenient location preferably in the main grooming area. The clubs will still have the right to have paid reserved grooming areas. The effective date will be January 1, 2013.

The AKC Board approved the following under the new judging approval procedures. A Parent Club may recommend that a member of the club be approved as a judge of their breed. The parent club must have been recognized by AKC for ten years, the applicant must have 20 years in the breed and have been a member of the Parent Club for at least 10 years. Parent Clubs may also invite someone who is not an AKC-approved judge to judge its specialty shows.

New Free AKC Reports

- (1) <u>Results by Breed</u>. On the AKC website, click on "Events". Then Click on "Single Breed Past Events". Select type of event, breed and month/year, then click on "Search". All shows/trials that meet that criteria will be displayed. Then click on the show/trial to see the actual results. For example, selecting "Rally", "Borzoi", "May 2012", displayed 11 rally trials that had at least 1 borzoi that earned a qualifying score.
- (2) <u>Display of Judges Assigned For A Single Breed</u>. On the AKC website, click on "Events". Select "Conformation". Then select "Breed" and "State", and click on "Search". (Up to 10 states can be selected). Future shows are displayed, with their location, show date, closing date, show secretary/superintendent, and the selected breed judge, group judge and BIS show. This is an easy way to review upcoming shows and see who the borzoi judges are.

Where To Find News About Borzoi, For Free

Are you one of the borzoi owners who miss getting a printed borzoi magazine? I liked having all the show news, litter announcements, pictures of new champions, etc., in one place, in a magazine to read. The drawback, was that one had to wait for the news in the monthly or quarterly printed magazine, and pay for the magazine. Today, this information is scattered about, on various websites, and on Facebook, but it is free. There are a couple of free online "magazines" for news about borzoi . If you don't have a computer at home - go to the library. Most libraries had computers that are connected to the internet, and the librarians will assist you with getting online. If you have a home computer, make sure you download the free ADOBE software, so you can read "pdf" files http://get.adobe.com/reader/

The Borzoi Club of America publishes quarterly, the Aristocrat as a pdf file. Go to www.borzoiclubofamerica.org, at the top select "Publications", click on "BCOA Aristocrat", then on the right side, click on the date for the issue you want. The Aristocrat has information about club events, news about members' dogs, and articles about all borzoi (not just member owned borzoi). Cindy Michalak is a regular columnist writing "Unique Zoitiques", and including color pictures. The "Top Producers" article is published once a year. The summer issue has pictures and results about the National Specialty.

The America Kennel Club publishes the monthly "AKC Gazette" online. Jon Steele writes an article about borzoi in the February, May, August and November issues. The other breed columns often have general information that apply to all dogs, not just that breed. Go to www.akc.org Click on "AKC Magazines" on the left, which is the 6th line down. Next screen, on the left, click on either "AKC Gazette (digital image) which is the 3rd line down, or the 4th line down "AKC Gazette PDF". (Both these selections also show up in the center of that screen). For both the digital image and for the pdf image, the next screen will be a list of dates, so select the month/year of the issue you want to read. The pdf version can be viewed on your computer screen, as long as your computer has the ADOBE software for reading. The digital version of the AKC Gazette is also easy to read and here are some tips: On the upper left corner there is a square icon with arrows at the corners - click on it, to view the page full screen. At the bottom of the page, in the center, is the page counter, and clicking on the arrow, lets you move from page to page. Also at the bottom, right corner is a printer icon, to let you print a page.
